IN AMERICA, WE DON'T DO KINGS

On June 14—Flag Day—Donald Trump wants tanks in the street and a made-for-TV display of dominance for his birthday. A spectacle meant to look like strength. But real power isn't staged in Washington. It rises up everywhere else.

No Kings is a nationwide day of defiance. From city blocks to small towns, from courthouse steps to community parks, we're taking action to reject authoritarianism—and show the world what democracy really looks like.

We're not gathering to feed his ego. We're building a movement that leaves him behind.

The flag doesn't belong to Donald Trump. It belongs to us. We're not watching history happen. We're making it.

On June 14th, we're showing up everywhere he isn't—to say no thrones, no crowns, no kings.

Action

This week brought us an offensive and disrespectful AI generated image of Trump as Pope. Project 2025s blueprint for a Christian Nationalist Regime change has come into focus.

Christian Nationalists believe the Federal Government should declare the U.S. a Christian Nation, basing our laws on their doctrine which excludes immigration, foreign aid, the environment, virtually all programs aiding the poor and the list goes on. Trump has put Christian Nationalists in key government roles, chilling free speech. He openly questions the principle of separation between church and state, challenging the First Amendment's Establishment Clause.

Separation of Church and State was created to protect Americans from exactly this kind of favoritism. He has appointed Paula White, a "Prosperity" Gospel Preacher, to oversee a White House Faith office and an Anti-Christian Bias Task Force, claims of which are shown to provide cover for white supremacy. This will enable them to continue dismantling government institutions with their anti-Democratic movement.

This is the antithesis of the religious freedom Trump proclaims to protect.

Reach out in letters and talk to your religious leaders, encourage them to speak out vehemently in their sermons and teachings against Trump's doctrine which is incompatible with American democracy, where freedom will be redefined to create a license to discriminate. (Let's not forget his Muslim ban!)

Even if you are not religious, take heed, your views will be defined as anti-Christian. So please write to national religious leaders of all faiths and implore them to strongly condemn Trump's efforts to dissolve the line between Separation of Church and State. Join James Madison, Thomas Jefferson and Voltaire in championing freedom of speech and religion.
